Submissions must reach the Leigh Square Community Arts Village no later than the deadline date and time. Exhibit Synopsis: In collaboration with the Cascadia Region Green Building Council, local schools, building practitioners, and other interested stakeholders, this multi media exhibition will examine the growing movement and impact of greening and sustainability in architecture, design and community practises. How can art and architecture be created that embraces or critiques the idea of “going green”? Challenge yourself to work with alternative and recycled media in order to create an exhibition that has something to say about the Green Revolution. Designers – showcase your future designs and your current projects. Educate and promote a green future. What are similarities or difference between art and design?

Exhibition dates are June 3rd - July 26th, 2010.

General: All submissions must be the artists/designers original work. The following will not be considered for exhibition:

- Copies of another artist’s or designers work
- No Art works can be made in part or whole from kits or commercial moulds

Exhibition submissions: Successful entries must ensure that art and design work:

- is dry/completed and ready to be exhibited by the submission deadline
- If 2D, the work is suitably framed and/or ready for hanging
- Works on canvas are stretched and gallery ready or are suited with grommets for other hanging methods
- 2 D design projects are mounted on an appropriate substrate with display method included
- Submitted works are undamaged
- work can pass through a standard double door
- 3D exhibits are stable and secure
- Artwork can, but is not required to be for sale. In the case of a sale, the artist will receive 80% of the selling price and 20% will go to the Friends of Leigh Square Society.
- Artists agree to insure work during exhibition dates and while in transit to/from Leigh Square Community Arts Village if applicable.
- For performance pieces, film, poems and other literary works, we will arrange for a mutually agreeable date.

NOTE: NO CRITIQUE OR COMMENT WILL BE PROVIDED. NO SUBMISSIONS WILL BE RETURNED.
