SOME LIKE IT HOT, BUT LOTS DON'T Political Climate Change and The Design Community

David Orr, Paul Sears Distinguished Professor of Environmental Studies and Politics, Oberlin College



One of the nation's most important architects of environmental literacy in higher education and a pioneer of the sustainability movement, this transformational educator will outline a national climate change policy for the incoming administration developed by the Presidential Climate Action Plan. He'll also present how the design and build community can contribute to changing climate policy at the local level.

Orr's career as a scholar, teacher, author, speaker, and entrepreneur spans fields as diverse as environment and politics, environmental education, green building, and climate change. One of his most noted efforts is organizing the design of the first substantially green building on a U.S. college campus, the Adam Joseph Lewis Center, which was later named by the U.S. Department of Energy as "One of Thirty Milestone Buildings in the 20th Century."
