Conferences

2002 – 2008

- **2002** - Joshua Cloud represents Cascadia in the forming of the National “Emerging Green Builders”
- **2006** - Cascadia EGB leaders attended Greenbuild 2006 in Denver to voice issues & concerns with the Emerging Green Builders National Committee.
- **2007** – Cascadia EGB presents NTDC winners at regional Living Future Conference.
- **2008** – Cascadia EGB organizes closing event and presents NTDC winners at LF.

2004

- **NOVEMBER** - Joshua Cloud creates the University of Washington EGB (UW-EGB) to serve as an umbrella group to connect the many environmental groups at University of Washington to the activities of the Cascadia Chapter.
- **DECEMBER** - The Seattle Steering Committee asks Joshua Cloud to join the group to represent the UW-EGB.

2005

- **SPRING** - EGB activities consist of working with University of Washington student groups to pass the *Washington State High Performance Building Law*.
- **SUMMER** - EGB *LEED Certified building tour series* is created in Seattle, Turner construction hosts EGB events.

2006

- **WINTER** - Cascadia EGB is formed to represent the regions growing interest in EGB. Joshua Cloud and Aleisha Smith begin working together as co-chairs of the Cascadia EGB.
- **APRIL** – Aleisha Smith forms the PSU EGB satellite group **and** hosts film showing of *“The Next Industrial Revolution”*
- **JUNE** - The first Cascadia *EGB Leaders Summit* is held in Seattle. EGB leaders from OR, WA, and BC meet to discuss regional/national involvement, to create Cascadia EGB mission & goals, and to discuss future initiatives.
- **JULY** – Portland EGB hosts *“LEED Intro & Strategic Meeting”* with Green Building Services with large turnout of young professionals.
- **AUGUST** – Cascadia EGB begins work on 2007 *EGB Natural Talent Design Competition*.

- **JANUARY** – Natural Talent Design Competition is launched!
- **FEBRUARY** – *LEED for Homes Eco-Charrette* designed for the Natural Talent Design Competition participants. Hosted by Sera Architects and Earth Advantage.
- **APRIL** – Cascadia EGB Leaders Summit takes place after Cascadia's Regional Conference Living Future. Local NTDC winners are recognized at conference.
- **NOVEMBER** – NTDC winners attend GreenBuild.
