### *How to prepare, organize, and submit*

For the August SLUG meeting, Jon Hall, AIA, SBA, and Senior Associate at GGLO will walk attendees through the process of submitting a project successfully for LEED Certification. He will cover the components of a LEED application, assembly and management best practices, and winning strategies.

He will discuss the Broadway Crossing, which is the first affordable housing project to achieve a LEED-Silver certification in Seattle.
