The Eugene Branch of Cascadia Region Green Building Council is proud to host a building tour of the Slocum Center for Orthopedics and Sports Medicine. This 80,000 square foot medical office building was completed in 2007 and has submitted documentation to the USGBC for LEED Gold certification. The Slocum Center was awarded the Mayor's first "Bold Steps Towards Sustainability" award in 2007. Features in the building include an advanced heating and cooling system, low-VOC materials inside, native landscaping and on-site stormwater management.
