

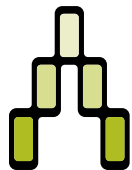

AN INTRODUCTION TO THE INTEGRATED DESIGN PROCESS AND DESIGN SYNERGIES

Gain the tools and techniques to actively participate in collaborative project decision-making – a necessary element for creating cost-effective and environmentally sound buildings. The Integrated Design Process is a new model for team communication and information sharing that maximizes design goals and benefits, while minimizing project cost and impact.

This workshop provides an introduction to the integrated design process, both in theory and in practice. We will look at how the traditional project management process needs to shift and adapt to enable IDP, and also at how the roles and responsibilities of project team members are delineated in IDP.

Integral to achieving successful sustainable building projects, this training is essential for all building industry professionals – from designer to owner.

DESIGN SYNERGIES is a 1 hour seminar that will address how integrated design synthesizes climate, use, loads and systems to deliver a more comfortable, productive and energy-efficient environment, while meeting project requirements and budget.
