## **Designing for Energy-Efficiency in Retail, Office, and School Buildings**

Of all commercial buildings in the United States, 98 percent are 100,000 square feet or less. Office, retail, and school buildings account for nearly 50 percent of total energy consumed by commercial buildings in this country.

Puget Sound Energy has developed a straight-forward process for developing energy-efficient buildings in this sector. By selecting a package of recommended efficiency measures, annual energy savings of 10 percent or more are achievable. Financial incentives range from \$0.50 to \$2.60 per square foot for basic participation in the program, with more funding available for optional enhanced measures. Detailed energy simulation and measure cost documentation are not required for participation in this program.

David Landers of PSE's Business Energy Management group will provide an overview of the PSE Prescriptive Approach for Whole Buildings. The presentation will focus on eligibility and participation requirements, along with a discussion of how this program works well in concert with LEED and BPA efficiency programs.
