Post Occupancy Evaluation of Washington Middle School: An OSPI Pilot Project for the Washington Sustainable Schools Protocol

The modernization and addition to Washington Middle School was one of the first OSPI pilot projects using the Washington Sustainable Schools Protocol. This 98,000 square foot middle school in the Olympia School District was completed in 2006. Sustainable strategies used include energy star roofing, rain water harvesting, photovoltaic solar system, numerous water use reduction elements, extensive daylighting, as well as CFD modeling to optimize the natural ventilation and passive cooling design. The panelists will discuss the Post Occupancy Evaluation of the sustainable elements.

DWAYNE EPP, AIA, LEED AP, ASSOCIATE | MAHLUM ARCHITECTS

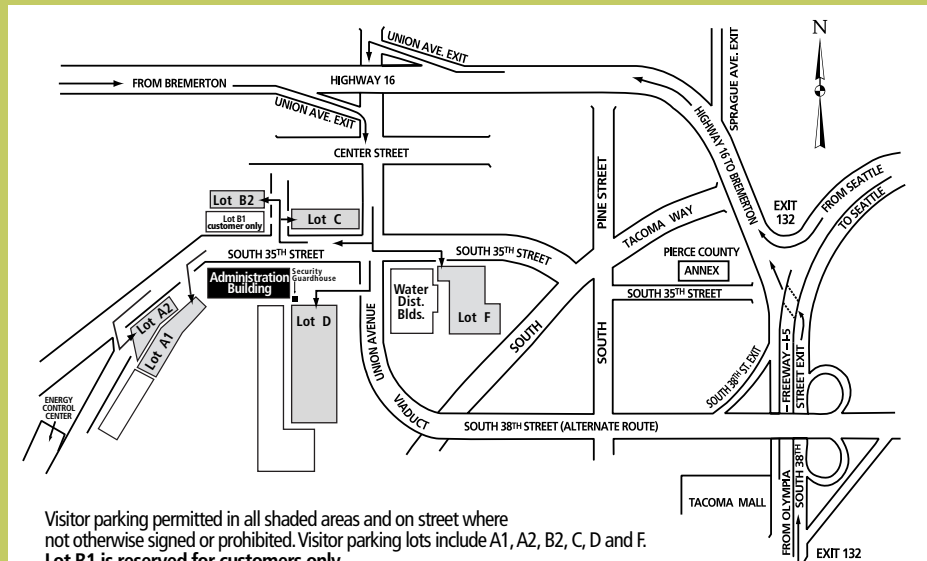
