The Nines luxury hotel occupies the upper nine floors of the historic Meier & Frank department store. Reuse as a hotel was made possible through interventions such as the cutting of a seven-story daylight atrium and an innovative viscous-damper seismic upgrade. Significant sustainability efforts include low-emitting finishes, water and energy reduction, and green housekeeping, all of which were still rare in luxury hotel properties when this LEED Silver project began.
