



# LEED Canada NC 2009: Technical Review

<b>DATE</b>	Thursday, September 23 <sup>rd</sup> , 2010
<b>DESCRIPTION</b>	<p>This one day interactive workshop provides a technical review of the LEED Canada NC 2009 Rating System. Technologies and strategies that can assist in achieving credits are discussed, and participants are given the opportunity to begin to consider the synergies between various credits. Case studies have been created to assist participants in applying their learning in relation to a real project scenario. This workshop also briefly identifies changes that have occurred during the evolution of the NC 1.0 Rating System and Addendum, to the 2009 system.</p> <p>*Any CaGBC workshop will meet eligibility requirements for the Green Associate exam.</p>
