Buchan Building Tour

The Buchan Building serves as a new Education and Community Center for the First Unitarian Church of Portland. This 20,000 square foot building will be completed in September 2007 and is expected to achieve LEED Gold certification.

The building will provide a variety of uses for the church and the general public, featuring a large reception area with an adjacent courtyard, a two-story atrium and 12 new classrooms.

The building is the newest addition to the First Unitarian campus and serves as a focal point for the block. The building incorporates a number of green features oriented toward energy and water conservation, stormwater management, sustainable building materials and a healthy indoor environment.
